Offices to be Elected and Timeline**

**Elections will be held for the following:**

**1. CSEA Board of Directors**

Vice President (to be elected to fill the last two years of a three year term)  
Middle School Director (to be elected to fill the last year of a two year term)  
Coronado Region Director (to be elected to a two year term)  
Doherty Region Director (to be elected to a two year term)  
Mitchell Region Director (to be elected to a two year term)  
Palmer Region Director (to be elected to a two year term)  
Wasson Region Director (to be elected to a two year term)

**2. CSEA Representatives to the NEA Representative Assembly**

CSEA is allotted ten delegates. The President is automatically elected as one of those ten. Nine additional delegates will be elected. CSEA will provide funding for a limited number of delegates based on the 2009-2010 budget and funding guidelines.

**3. CEA State At-Large and CEA Region Five representatives to the NEA Representative Assembly**

The number of nominations submitted to CEA did not exceed the number of positions open. There will be no election in either category. Automatically elected were Sandy Cox for a one year term as a CEA State At-Large representative and Rick Garcia for a two year term as a Region Five representative. In addition, Jeff Marshall will serve the last year of a two term as Region Five representative.

**4. Amendments to the CEA Articles of Incorporation**

Information on the proposed amendments will be provided to CSEA by CEA after March 1.
