## Contract Fact

### Article XVII. D. 2.

Where multiple teachers begin work on the same date, those teachers shall participate in a drawing to determine position on the seniority list. This drawing shall be held within thirty (30) days of the initial hiring date. The Board shall notify the Association and the Association shall thus have the opportunity to have a representative present at all such drawings. The individuals affected shall be notified of the drawing prior to the date it shall be held and they shall also be notified of the results of the drawing. All drawings shall be conducted openly and at a time and place which will reasonably allow affected teachers and Association representatives to be in attendance.
