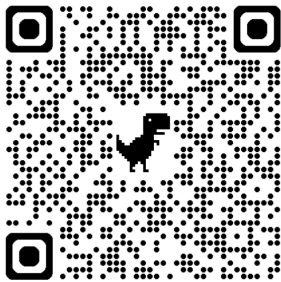
Planning for Dec 4th School Board Meeting Turnout Checklist and Petition Follow Through and Final push.

### Common Questions About Master Agreement

1. Q:What is the “Master Agreement”  
A: It is our contract that guarantees our rights and benefits.
2. Q: Why are we mobilizing people to the Dec 4th and January 8th School Board Meeting?  
A: We want the board to know that our contract is important to us. The deadline for the board to decide whether to continue the contract is January 15th. December 4th and January 8th are the last two school board meetings prior to the board severing the contract.
3. Q: Why is preserving our Master Agreement Important?  
A: This is about the right of our union to exist. The employer is threatening to withdraw recognition of our union, and our contract. That means that every benefit we have been guaranteed in our contract is now subject to change and or elimination at any time without notice... Think Healthcare, Think Wages, Think Retirement, Think Medical leave, Think Academic Freedom, Think Free Speech– All of it is at Risk.
4. Q: What is our plan to resist and Fight this this attack?  
A: We are going to do the simple things well. We are going to make sure there is a functioning building committee at every work site/school. We are going to mobilize parents so they understand what is at risk for their children. We are going to engage in escalating actions that demonstrate our collective power and our essential value to the community of Colorado Springs at large.
